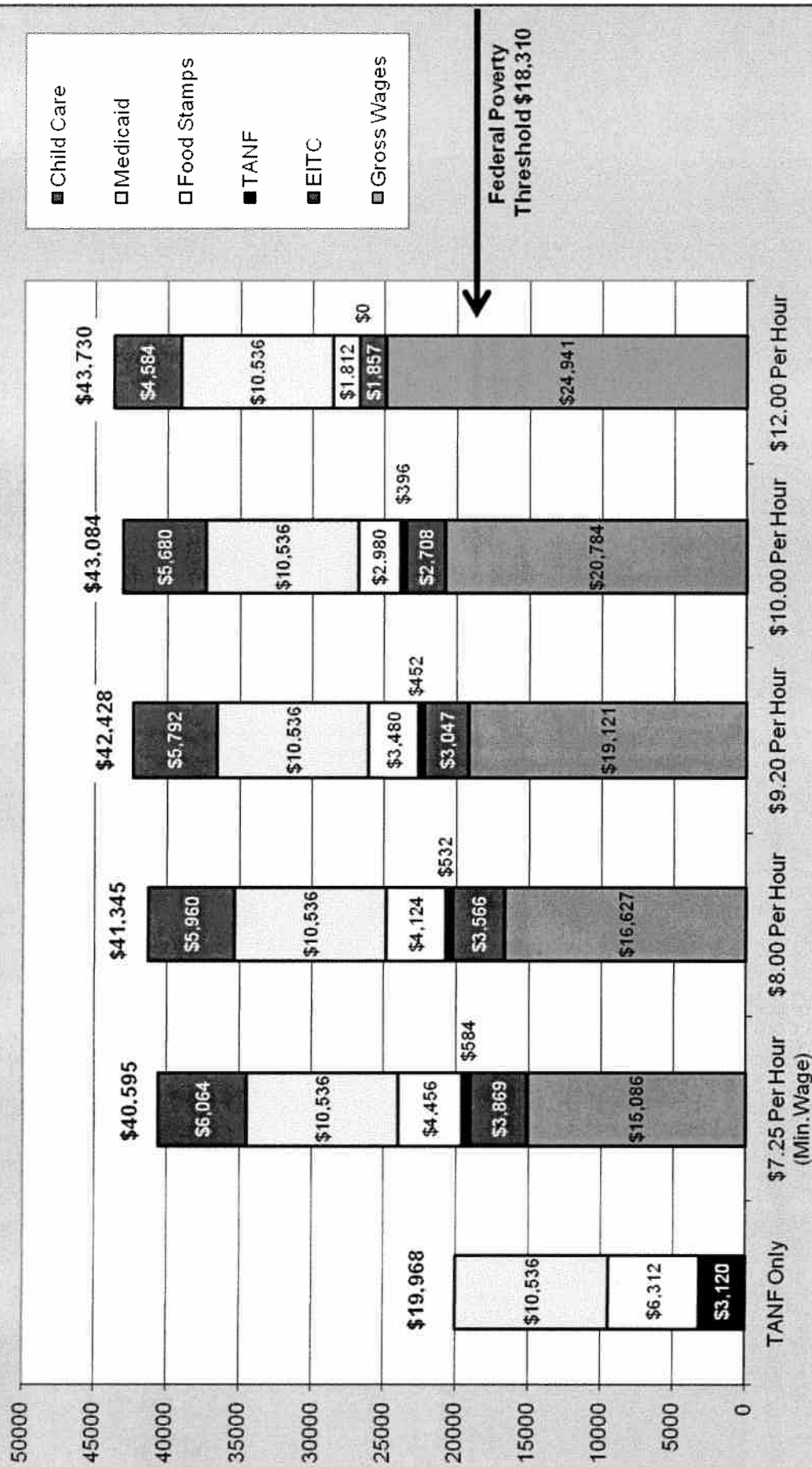

2010 Annual Wage and Benefit Scenarios for a Single Parent with Two Children

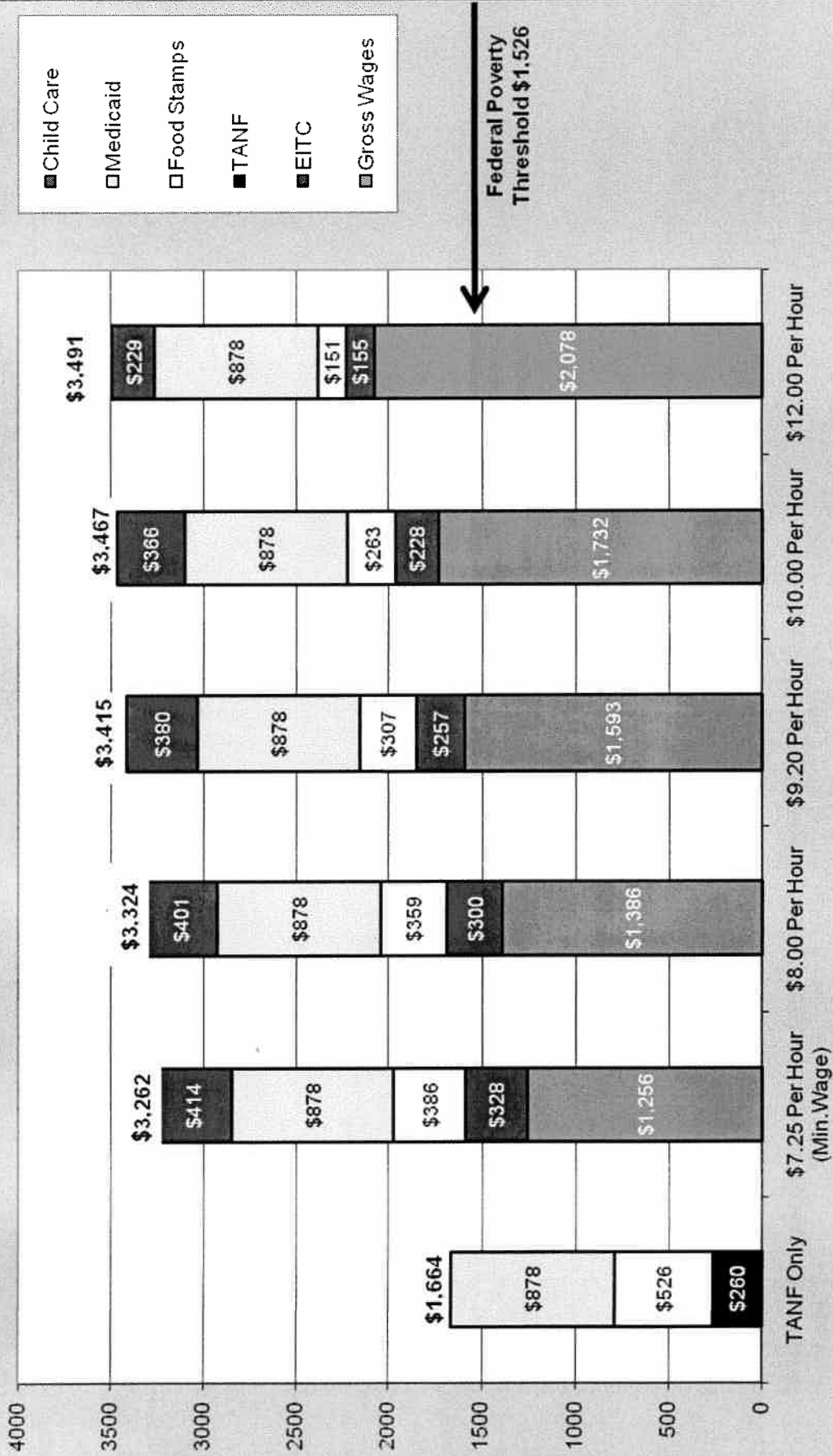
(Calculated Assuming Full-time Employment of 40 Hours per Week & Four Months of Earned Income Disregard)
